DISCUSSIONS

The Board met this 4th day of March 2025 to consider the annexation petition of Richard Spoor, agent to annex 58.9661 acres to the Village of Maineville pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 709.23 (Expedited Type 2.

Bruce McGary, Assistant Prosecutor, stated that he had reviewed the file and that the annexation meets the criteria needed for approval and that no objection had been received from the Hamilton Township.

Upon discussion, the Board resolved (Resolution #25-0308) to approve the annexation of 58.9661 acres to the Village of Maineville, Richard Spoor, agent, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 709.023 [A.K.A. Expedited Type 2 Annexation].

Elizabeth James, Senior Advisor for Enbridge Inc. was present to update the Board on the upgrades being made at the Texas Eastern gas pipeline facility located in Clearcreek Township.

Commissioner Jones stated that she had recently attended a NACo (National Association of Counties) legislative conference and learned that Congress is considering eliminating the tax benefit on tax-free Municipal Bonds.

There was discussion as to how this could impact financing of County projects.
